Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu spoke by telephone on Monday with US President Joe Biden and told him he was determined to see Operation Guardian of the Walls through and hit Hamas hard.

The Prime Minister's Office stated that Netanyahu "expressed appreciation for the president's consistent support for Israel's right to defend itself," and told Biden that he "was determined to complete the operation's goal of restoring security to Israeli citizens."

The two have spoken several times in recent days. Biden is reportedly pushing for a ceasefire while Netanyahu is apparently unwavering on his determination to complete the objectives set forth by the IDF in Operation Guardian of the Walls.

According to the White House, Biden "reiterated his firm support for Israel's right to defend itself against indiscriminate rocket attacks" and "encouraged Israel to make every effort to ensure the protection of innocent civilians."

The two discussed "progress in Israel's military operations against Hamas and other terrorist groups in Gaza," and Biden "expressed his support for a ceasefire" and discussed US engagement with Egypt and other partners towards that end.

The State Department stated Wednesday morning that Deputy Assistant Secretary of State Hady Amr continued his consultations on behalf of Secretary of State Tony Blinken to "restore calm and put an end to the violence."

He met with Palestinian Authority head Mahmoud Abbas, PA prime Minister Mouhamad Shtayyeh, and other PA officials. He met with Israeli officials on Sunday, with no significant results.

Netanyahu stated Monday night after an assessment that "the directive is to continue striking at the terrorist targets. The IDF is doing this very well. We will continue to take whatever action necessary to restore quiet and security to all residents of Israel."

The Israeli prime minister told the American president he "is determined to complete the operation's goal of restoring security to Israeli citizens."



Netanyahu noted that "Israel would continue to strike at Hamas and Islamic Jihad in order to restore the quiet and security to the citizens of Israel."

In the meantime, Israel is receiving broad support from countries around the world.

Netanyahu spoke on Monday night with German Chancellor Angela Merkel who reiterated her "unreserved support for Israel's right to defend itself."

Netanyahu emphasized that "Hamas is committing a double war crime by firing missiles from inside civilian populations and by using civilians in Gaza as human shields."

On Sunday night, Netanyahu spoke to Dutch Prime Minister Mark Rutte and thanked him for "his country's support of Israel's right to selfdefense in light of the terrorist organizations' firing at Israel's cities."

Austria, the Czech Republic, Slovenia, and other countries flew Israeli flags on their government buildings in solidarity of the Jewish state.

Sheikh Jarrah: The Facts

What really happened in Sheikh Jarrah, and what the laws are pertaining to the property that was the subject of the dispute that preceded the current military operation.

A long-simmering controversy over the fate of Jewish-owned land and Palestinian tenants in the Sheikh Jarrah neighborhood of Jerusalem has once again become front page news after yet another court decision reaffirming the pre-1948 Jewish ownership of the land and the obligation of the Palestinian tenants to pay their rent or be evicted. At the same time, false claims have been made that the Israeli laws are unfair because Jews can recover property in the West Bank, but Palestinians can't recover property in pre-1967 Israel.

While Sheikh Jarrah is home to the American Colony Hotel and the former Orient House of the late Faisal Husseini, it is perhaps best known to Jews for two reasons:

First, in April 1948 Palestinian attackers carried out a horrific massacre in Sheikh Jarrah, killing 78 Jewish doctors, nurses, patients and others, who were in a convoy up to Mt. Scopus and Hadassah Hospital. The massacre was observed by British soldiers, who did nothing to stop it.

Second, the proximity of Sheikh Jarrah to the Tomb of Simon the Just, a prominent Second Temple High Priest. Simon's Tomb has been a Jewish pilgrimage site for many hundreds of years, and religious Jews have therefore been eager to buy land and live in the area. In 1876 Jews bought Simon's Tomb and an adjacent field of 18 dunams from Arab owners. The buyer, a committee of Sephardic and Ashkenazi Jews,

these Israeli Arabs were now citizens of an enemy state.

divided the property. While the Ashkenazi half remained vacant, the Sephardic Jews began building homes on their half, establishing a community that eventually numbered in the hundreds before diminishing in the face of Arab violence in the 1930's.

Sheikh Jarrah After 1948

During the war invading Jordanian forces took Judea and Samaria, including Sheikh Jarrah and other parts of Jerusalem, and the Jews who survived the fighting had to flee. The Jordanian Custodian of Enemy Property took control of all West Bank property owned by Jews including Jewish buildings and land in Sheikh Jarrah. Incidentally, the Jordanian Custodian also took property in the West Bank that belonged to Arabs who continued to live in what became Israel, since like Israeli Jews, these Israeli Arabs were now citizens of an enemy state.

(It should be mentioned that the laws underlying the Jordanian Custodian of Enemy Property, and the similar Israeli Custodian of Absentee Property that will be discussed below, were based on inherited British Mandate law, which is why the offices had similar names and responsibilities.)

Ownership of much of the Jewish land taken by the Jordanian Custodian was transferred to the Jordanian government, which used it, for example, to construct government buildings in East Jerusalem, and to create the Dheisheh Refugee Camp – which is built entirely on Jewish-owned land. In addition, Palestinian refugee camps at Qalandia and Anata were built in part on Jewish land that had been taken by the Custodian. (See Arab Building in Jerusalem: 1967—1997, Israel Kimhi, p48-49; for Dheisheh, see also, from the leaked Palestine papers, NSU Draft Memo Re: Rights of Jews Within the OPT Acquired pre-1967.)

In 1956 the Jordanian Government reached an agreement with UNRWA to use the vacant Ashkenazi land in Sheikh Jarrah to build houses for 28 Palestinian refugee families. Under the scheme the Custodian **leased the land** to the Jordanian Ministry of Development, and the United Nations (UNRWA) funded the construction:

The refugees would agree to give up their refugee assistance and ration cards and would pay nominal rent for a probationary period of three years and three months. Those tenants who lived up to the lease terms would be allowed to sign a long-term lease of 30 years, and after that a further 33 years.

The tenants claim that under a side agreement they received title to their homes after the initial three-year period, but there is no evidence of such an arrangement, which would obviously conflict with the fact that they had to sign a lease.

In any event, there is no evidence that any of the 28 families ever gained title to the homes from Jordan or UNRWA. They were tenants paying rent.

The Situation After 1967

Speaking generally, the Jordanian government purchased, or took by eminent domain, much of the Jewish property held by the Custodian, at which point the property being held in trust for the Jewish owner was replaced by the money gained in the transaction. The property in question was no longer Jewishowned, and even after 1967 there is no way for the original Jewish owners to regain rights to such property, such as the previously mentioned Dheisheh Refugee Camp and Jordanian government buildings. The Jewish owners were only able to file for compensation from the Israeli Custodian who took over for the Jordanian Custodian.

In contrast to this, the land in Sheikh Jarrah was exceptional as it continued to be held in trust for the Jewish owners by the Jordanian Custodian, and then by the Israeli Custodian after 1967.

Is the Land Really Jewish Owned?

The Jordanian Custodian took the land in Sheikh Jarrah after 1948 because it was Jewish-owned, and in the next 19 years no one in the West Bank or Jordan disputed the fact that it was Jewish-owned land. While in recent years some Palestinians have come forward claiming to be the rightful owners of the land, their silence for so many years, especially when the land was first taken by the Jordanian Custodian, makes their claims extremely dubious, and Israeli courts have consistently found against them.

Israeli Government Not Expelling Anyone

It must be stressed also that this is a civil dispute over ownership rights and rent, and the Israeli government is not a party to the litigation. Over the years some of the Palestinian tenants have been evicted over nonpayment of rent, but this is a private rather than a government matter. The Israeli government is not evicting anyone.

Once the Jewish claimants proved their ownership to the Sheikh Jarrah land in court, they also did not try to evict the Palestinian families – they merely informed them they would have to pay rent. In 1982 the Jewish owners sued the Palestinian tenants for non-payment of rent and the lawyer representing the Palestinian families did not dispute the Jewish ownership of the land. Instead, he worked out a court-sanctioned agreement between the Jewish owners and the Palestinians, under which the families would agree to pay rent and would be considered "protected tenants." As such, they could not be evicted if they lived up to the lease, including by paying rent, and under certain circumstances their families could inherit their rights to the apartment.

Perhaps under pressure from the PLO, along with monetary inducements, most but not all of the tenants soon renounced the agreement and once again claimed they owned the units and refused to pay rent.

Israel's Handling of Palestinian Land

Property left behind by Arabs who fled during the fighting in 1948 (i.e., absentee property) was turned over Israel's Custodian of Absentee Property, which sold most of the property to state or related bodies for public purposes, such as housing the hundreds of thousands of Jewish refugees from Arab countries who found refuge in Israel. The Custodian held the value of the property in trust for the registered Arab owner (with adjustments for inflation and interest).

Those registered owners are eligible to file for compensation from the Custodian, but Palestinians were pressured not to make claims, lest that legitimize Israel's existence and sovereignty. Still, over the years at least 14,692 claims have been filed, claims have been settled with respect to more than 200,000 dunums of land, more than 10,000,000 NIS (New Israeli Shekels) has been paid in compensation, and more than 54,000 dunums of replacement land in Israel has been given in compensation. Israel has followed this generous policy despite the fact that not a single penny of compensation has ever been paid to any of the more than 500,000 Jewish refugees from Arab countries, who were forced by the Arab governments to abandon their homes, businesses and savings.

Critics of Israel charging unfairness or "asymmetry" in application of absentee property laws might want to consider that asymmetry first.

"It is the struggle between intolerance and tolerance, between law-breaking violence and law and order," the Israeli prime minister said. Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said Monday that the Arab rioting in Jerusalem is part of the organized Palestinian campaign to cancel Jewish presence in the city.

Netanyahu made his comments as Palestinian leaders egged on rioters in the city who attacked police and appeared to be trying to break up the annual <u>Jerusalem Day celebrations</u> marking the reunification of the city that had been divided until 1967.

Palestinian leaders, including members of the Hamas terror group in Israel, incited their followers, claiming as usual that Israel was trying to usurp the Al Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem's Old City, a commonly used excuse to agitate for violence. Thousands of worshipers at the mosque rioted for several nights in a row, hurling rocks and bottles at police and on the plaza below where Jews and tourists gather at the Western Wall of the ancient Jewish Temple.

"A struggle is now being waged for the heart of Jerusalem. It is not a new struggle. It is the struggle between intolerance and tolerance, between lawbreaking violence and law and order," Netanyahu said. "This struggle is not new because it has been waged, in effect, over Jerusalem and the heart of Jerusalem for hundreds of years, since the rise of the three monotheistic faiths."

Noting the significance of Israel controlling the oncedivided city and guaranteeing access to members of all faiths to the holy sites – which was denied to Jews when it was under Jordanian occupation from 1948 until the Israeli victory in the June 1967 Six Day War – Netanyahu said Israeli governments were all committed to freedom of religion.

"It could be said that in the long history of Jerusalem, only under Israeli sovereignty since 1967 have we witnessed a prolonged, stable and safe period in which we have been working to ensure freedom of worship and tolerance for all," Netanyahu said. "This is not a mission that we can carry out without conflict from time to time with those same forces of intolerance that want to expropriate our rights – first of all our rights, but not just ours – on the Temple Mount and other holy sites."

Netanyahu's comments came shortly after an Arab mob attacked an Israeli car outside the Old City walls. As dozens of Arabs hurled rocks at the vehicle and tried to lynch the occupants, a police officer ran up, firing his gun in the air, and rescued the passengers as the mob was beating them. The driver, a young man named Ephraim, suffered a head wound in the attack that was interrupted at the last second, when his life was saved.

"We insist on ensuring the rights of everyone. This occasionally requires taking a strong stand, as the officers of the Israel Police and our security forces are doing at the moment," Netanyahu said. "We back them in this just struggle.

"Of course, these things are being expressed erroneously and misleadingly in the global media. In the end truth will win but we must constantly reiterate it."



Netanyahu's mandate at an end, rivals compete for their chance at the premiership! It will likely be opposition leader Yair

It will likely be opposition leader Yair Lapid who gets the mandate.

With Prime Minister Benjamin's Netanyahu's opportunity to form a government having ended at midnight Wednesday, his political rivals are vying for a bid to be given the chance to build a coalition. In one of his most important functions, it's Israel's president, Reuven Rivlin, who gets to decide who will be next. He met with Naftali Bennett of the Yemina party and Yair Lapid of Yesh Atid. He also met with members of other parties to hear their recommendations.

It will most likely be Lapid who gets the mandate. He received 51 recommendations from various parties to Bennett's seven. Among those recommending Lapid was the right-wing New Hope party led by Gideon Saar.

The probability that Yemina would also join such a government appears high. According to sources in Yesh Atid's party, Lapid has already agreed to Bennett's condition that he serve first as prime minister in a power-sharing agreement.

Israeli researchers find way to detect water contamination before it reaches your tap

In most cases in Israel, the water that flows from the tap is completely safe and can be drunk without a second thought. Elsewhere around the world, however, this is not the case. According to the 2020 UN Global Water Development Report, around two-thirds of the global population experience severe water shortages for at least one month out of the year.

And even when water does reach the tap, it is not always safe to drink due to contamination – a widespread issue affecting roughly 500 million people worldwide.

In 2012 alone, an estimated 842,000 deaths from middle and low-income countries stemmed from contaminated drinking water.

"In the United States, for example, water pollution of various kinds leads to tens of thousands of hospitalizations a year, and the estimated cost of treating these diseases and infections is over \$1 billion," says Prof. Shlomo Sela of the Department of Food Science at the Volcani Center, Agricultural Research Organization at Rishon Lezion.

This problem also extends to Israel where pesticides have historically been the major agrochemical pollutants contaminating the country's groundwater aquifers, as well as pollution from sources like sewer line malfunctions or damaged pipes.

The possible catalysts of pollution are especially numerous when it comes to water from surface-level sources. Contaminated drinking water is a major issue around the world. Now Israeli researchers have found a way to detect contaminated water in real time before it reaches our homes.

"In the past, when most of our water supply was from the Sea of Galilee, there was fear of pollution because of floods, which could mix with animal excrement or pesticides from agriculture in the area," says Sela.

"Currently, a test is performed in Israel that aims to detect the presence of bacteria in water once a day, and only after 24 hours can the results be seen," he explains.

Due to the length of time required to obtain the test results, there may be cases where fluid contaminants will only be detected after they have already reached the tap in the consumer's home. "That's why we sometimes hear on the news about polluted drinking water from a particular area, and why citizens are asked to boil the water to kill the bacteria."

For a country that has routinely experienced chronic water shortages, rectifying this issue is imperative. Now, an <u>Israeli study</u> has developed an innovative method to quickly detect bacterial infections in drinking water supply systems before it reaches the consumer.

Locating the pollution

Funded by the Israeli government's Water Authority, the new study aimed to assess fluorescence spectroscopy as a tool to rapidly measure and evaluate the microbial quality of water.

"The new method we have developed offers the possibility of knowing about an adverse change in the quality of the water in the drinking water supply systems in real time," says Sela.

It is intended to prevent situations in which water contaminants are detected too late, and to ensure that water free of bacterial contaminants reaches the consumer's home.

The method is based on a combination of fluorescence measurements alongside advanced statistical tools and machine learning.

Sensors illuminate the bacterium at a specific wavelength and obtain a reflection at another wavelength. This makes it possible to detect infections up to the level of 10,000 bacteria within one milliliter of water.

According to Sela, the sensors will be scattered at critical points of the national water transport system. "The wider the layout, the easier it will be to identify the affected area," he says. "The contamination alert will be received on the main computer and the mobile phones of the operating personnel of the water supplier," he explains.

"In a later phase, we are considering developing a cheap, but less smart sensor, which can connect to a domestic water filter machine in one's apartment and warn of a decrease in water quality due to a filter not being replaced in time, for example."



Two dead in direct hit in Ashkelon, school house struck as Hamas launches hundreds of rockets



May 11, 2021

firefighters battle a blaze after a Hamas rocket struck a school (Israel Fire Dept.)

Hamas gloated after it bombarded the city of Ashkelon. Over 400 rockets have been launched since last night. By David Isaac, World Israel News

At 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, Hamas announced that it had fired 137 heavy rockets in five minutes at the city of Ashkelon. Two women have been reported killed by a direct hit. A third, an 80-year-old woman, was extricated from the building. She is in critical condition.

The Barzilai Medical Center reported it has treated 84 casualties, two of theme in serious condition. Forty-nine casualties are currently being treated in the emergency room, Kan News reports. Three rockets made direct hits on buildings in the city.

One rocket struck a school. Firefighters struggled to put the fire out. No one was trapped inside as classes had been cancelled in areas near the Gaza Strip due to the security situation.

Analysis: Hamas is undermining Israel's sovereignty in Jerusalem

Sirens have sounded throughout southern Israel during the day as rockets continue to be launched into Israel. In the morning, dozens of rockets hit the city of Ashdod. A mother and daughter, 12, arrived at Assuta Hospital in Ashdod with shrapnel wounds, but were otherwise listed as lightly injured after a rocket struck their home. Before morning on Tuesday, a rocket made a direct hit on an apartment building in Ashkelon, injuring four.

The father, 40, was listed in serious condition having sustained a head injury. The mother, 39, was moderately injured. Their two children, ages 6 and 12, were lightly injured. Also lightly injured in the rocket strike were an 82-year-old woman and a 63-year-old man. The IDF has requested that Ashkelon residents remain in their reinforced rooms.

Israel returned fire, killing <u>several terrorists</u>. It also attacked a terror tunnel and other targets. Gaza's Health Ministry claims 26 have been killed and 122 injured.

The exchange of fire began on Monday after Hamas fired a rocket barrage at Jerusalem, the first time in years. The rocket attack and Arab riots in the capital put a halt to the annual Flags Parade to celebrate Jerusalem Day. One of the rockets narrowly missed hitting a home in a settlement on the outskirts of the city. The IDF has said the current round of fighting may last several days or lead to a still wider operation. It has struck over 130 targets since yesterday and has called up 5,000 reservists.
