## The path to peace begins in the classroom

UNRWA indoctrinates Palestinian kids into the culture of hate that calls a terror attack against Israelis a 'barbecue party'

With the United Nations General Assembly meeting this week, they are keen to bring to the attention of the world the education that is being provided in UNRWA schools.

We believe that the hate-filled education that has been provided to young Palestinians over the last three

generations is a leading cause of the failure to achieve

peace between the Israelis and the Palestinians.

Our message is simple: The education of Palestinian school children must change drastically if there is ever to be a lasting negotiated peace between Israelis and Palestinians. Why? indoctrinating them into a culture of hate, and thereby perpetuating the conflict, rather than resolving it. Until their education changes, the region is at least a generation away from a true, sustainable peace.

These Palestinian schools (in the PA-controlled West Bank, Hamas-controlled Gaza Strip, private schools belonging to the various Christian churches and Islamic charity foundations, as well as UNRWA schools) all receive their books from the Palestinian Authority Ministry of Education's Curricula Center in Ramallah. As concluded by Dr. Arnon Groiss, whose research on the subject spans 18 years, the most recent set of books published in 2016/2018 are even more radical than their predecessors.

"The Right of Return" for over 5 million Palestinians is taught as a birthright — clearly an attempt to destroy the State of Israel. Summer camps for UNRWA school children in Gaza are essentially Hamas paramilitary training camps. It is nothing short of hair-raising to see an adorable schoolgirl demonstrate the best way to stab a Jew, or to hear a young schoolboy say that he dreams of one day becoming a martyr.

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu delivered a statement following the coalition’s passage of the controversial “Reasonableness Bill.”

The bill was supported in its third reading by 64 Members of Knesset without opposing votes, after the opposition members left the Plenum Hall prior to the vote.

The version of the bill approved in the vote proposes to add to section 15 of Basic Law: The Judiciary the following wording: “In spite of what is stated in this basic law, those holding judicial power by law, including the Supreme Court sitting as the High Court of Justice, shall not hear [a case] nor issue an order against the Government, the Prime Minister or a Government minister, on the reasonableness of their decision; in this section, ‘decision’ means any decision, including on appointments, or a decision to refrain from exercising authority.”

“Dear citizens of Israel,” Netanyahu began, “I would like to begin with the most moving scene that I have witnessed in the past 24 hours. Last night, masses of Israelis came to demonstrate in favor of the reform and against the reform. On one side of the escalator in the Jerusalem train station stood the supporters, and in the opposite direction the opponents. These ascended and these descended. Everyone held flags, everyone shouted slogans, everyone was there from their heart.”

“Then, despite the differences of opinion, when they were near each other, someone extended a hand to his fellow. First one, and then another and then another.

They shook hands – not as enemies, not as people who hate each other, but as brothers. This is the people of Israel. This is our spirit. This is what we must aspire to always, and especially at this time.

“Today, we carried out a necessary democratic step, one designed to restore a measure of balance between the authorities, what we had here for 50 years. We passed the amendment to the reasonableness standard so that the elected government will be able to lead policy according to the will of the majority of the citizens of the state.

“In no way is carrying out the will of the voter ‘the end of democracy.’ It is the essence of democracy,” Netanyahu said, adding that “Due to the importance of the issue, the coalition worked throughout to reach consensus with the opposition.”

“This was not a given.”

“In previous cases of sharp public disagreement, the governments did not extend a hand to opponents of their policies: Not for the first Oslo Accords, not for the later Oslo Accords, not to the expulsion from Gush Katif and not the agreements that transferred areas of the state and gas fields to Lebanon, in effect to Hezbollah.

“But we acted differently. Here, we agreed to halt the legislation; we stopped it for three continuous months. We agreed to significant changes to the original policy.

“I say with regret: None of our compromise proposals were accepted, not one. Even in the plenum today, as the voting was underway, until the last moment, we tried to reach agreement but the other side consistently refused. I remind you that until recently, senior opposition figures supported changing the reasonableness standard. Others even agreed to cancel it altogether.

“But even if there was no agreement on the measured amendment that was submitted, in no way did this justify disrupting the lives of – and causing suffering to – millions of citizens who were unable to get to work, the hospital or the airport due to blocked highways, delayed ambulances, fires, and blocking Ben-Gurion International Airport.

“And despite everything my friends, we continued to strive for dialogue and to reach agreement. We are not giving up on the chance of reaching broad agreement – and I tell you that it is possible. Already in the coming days, the coalition will turn to the opposition in order to advance a dialogue between us. We are prepared to discuss everything, immediately, and do so in the round of talks during the Knesset recess and reach a comprehensive agreement on everything and we will add more time should it be needed, until the end of November. That is more than enough time to reach agreement on everything.

“We have consensus. We all agree that Israel needs to remain a strong democracy, that it will continue to safeguard individual rights for all, that it will not become a state governed by Jewish religious law, that the court will continue to be independent and that no side will control it. I would like to reiterate that: No side must be allowed to control the court. This will not happen on our watch.

“Citizens of Israel,

“We all need to agree on something else: The IDF must remain outside any political controversy. We all know that the IDF relies on dedicated reservists who love this country. Calls for refusal to serve harm the security of

every citizen of the state. No government can capitulate to refusal diktat and we will not give in to such diktat.

“I call on you – brother and sister reservists, leave IDF duty out of the political debate.

We have one state, one home, one people. On the eve of the

Ninth of Av, let us safeguard them together.

“I say to the leaders of the opposition: It is possible to continue to debate and argue but it is also possible to do something else: It is possible to reach consensus regarding what comes next.

Let us reach agreement. This is my call to you, and I extend my hand and call for peace and mutual respect between us.

Netanyahu concluded by warning Israel’s enemies not to perceive Israel’s internal disagreements as a sign of weakness. “A last word to our enemies: I know that you do not know what democracy is. Do not misunderstand this debate we are having. As always, we will stand shoulder to shoulder and together repel any threat to our dear country.”

# The limited potential of the operation in Jenin

As a limited, tactical engagement, the operation has limited, but important, potential. Over the past several weeks, the Palestinians have shot four rudimentary rockets at Israeli communities from Jenin. Although military experts insist these were mere pop guns, the missile industry in Gaza began the same way in 2000. Today, missiles from Gaza have ranges that cover most of the country. The operation in Jenin can destroy all the rocket workshops and kill or arrest all of the terrorist operatives engaged in the development of the rocket program.

The operation in Jenin can also disrupt and degrade the Palestinian terror capacity by killing and capturing the terror commanders and foot soldiers who together have been carrying out shooting, stoning, roadside bomb and pipe bomb attacks against Israelis throughout the region. These attacks have made life a crap shoot for tens of thousands of Israeli citizens who live and work in the

communities in northern Samaria and the Binyamin region.

In the hours before the operation in Jenin began, Palestinian terrorists carried out four shooting attacks against Israeli vehicles, communities and IDF personnel in the area around the city. To get a sense of the magnitude of the problem, every day Palestinians from Jenin and the wider area carry out hundreds of stoning attacks against Israeli vehicles on the roads. And according to the Shin Bet, in May alone, Palestinians attacked Israeli vehicles with Molotov cocktails 139 times. They carried out 51 pipe bomb attacks and 11 shooting attacks.

While some of the terror infrastructure behind these attacks is located in Nablus, and in villages like Huwara and Umm Tzafa, because of the free rein terror groups enjoy in Jenin, the bulk of the operational infrastructure is located in Jenin.



## Strategic problem

The fact that the current operation is a tactical engagement doesn't mean that the problem isn't strategic. It is. But unfortunately, the IDF doesn't share the Netanyahu government's understanding of the strategic realities on the ground. And as a result, a wider operation is unlikely.

This disparity was exposed Sunday by an in-depth study of Maj. Gen. Yehuda Fuchs and his ideological assessment of the region published by *Hakol Hayehudi* news service. The report included an interview with a top officer in Central Command. In a remarkable exchange, journalist Elchanan Groner asked the unnamed top officer whether the Palestinian Authority is Israel's enemy.

"Absolutely not. The Palestinians are not an enemy and the P.A. is not an enemy and really doesn't encourage terrorism," the top officer said.

The statement by the top officer was jaw-dropping. As Palestinian Media Watch reported last week, Fatah, the PLO faction led by P.A. chairman Mahmoud Abbas, bragged in its official media organs last week that U.S.-trained P.A. security personnel carry out two-thirds of all terrorist attacks against Israel.

The P.A. devotes 7% of its U.S.-funded budget to paying salaries to terrorists imprisoned in Israeli jails and pensions to the families of dead terrorists. These salaries rise with the severity of the crimes. The base salary is NIS 1,400 a month for rock throwers. Terrorists receive extra money if they murder Jews and the more Jews they murder, the more money they make. On average, the salary of terrorists is three times the average income in P.A.-ruled areas. Yet, the top Central Command officer insisted that the P.A. opposes terrorism.

In his words, "The P.A. views it as a failure when a member of their security forces shoots Israelis. They

handle it and put him in jail. I absolutely do not define them as an enemy."

He added, "It's possible that a day will come where they embark on another path, and then we'll define them as an enemy. Abu Mazen [aka Abbas] doesn't love us, but he opposes terrorism. He is terrible to us in the international arena. But he opposes terrorism."

Although he admitted that the P.A. pays salaries to terrorists, and that the policy is "a problematic story that is liable to encourage terrorism," he insisted that it is "very complicated."

## Central Command

Rather than focus on the P.A.'s role in the violence, in recent weeks, top Central Command officers have been focusing their ire on the Jews in the region. The day before the current operation in Jenin, Channel 11 reported that the IDF, Shin Bet and police are forming a joint unit to quell "settler violence."

The move followed a series of actions against Israeli Jews in the region capped off last week with Defense Minister Yoav Gallant's order to place four Israeli Jews under administrative detention for six months despite the absence of evidence of wrongdoing by them. A magistrate's court judge, citing the absence of incriminating evidence, ordered the four released from jail last week.

The current IDF onslaught against Israeli residents of the region came after last Saturday, when hundreds of area residents entered Umm Tzafa and set fire to Palestinian homes. The media, the Biden administration and the IDF all zoned in on the incident, using it to buttress the narrative that "settler violence" is the propellant driving Palestinian terrorism. That is, the presence of Jews in northern Samaria and the Binyamin region is the "root cause" of Palestinian terrorism.

Last Friday, *Maariv* journalist Kalman Liebskind exposed the full picture, which is quite different from the narrative that has taken hold. Last Monday, terrorists from the Palestinian village of Urif in the Binyamin

region massacred four Jews dining in a restaurant in the neighboring Jewish village of Eli. In the days following the massacre, Palestinians from the neighboring village of Umm Tzafa carried out continuous assaults on Jewish vehicles traveling on Route 465.

Rather than enter Umm Tzafa and round up the hundreds of villagers attacking the Israeli motorists with rocks and boulders, the IDF shut down Route 465 to Israeli traffic for several hours on Thursday and again on Friday morning.

On Saturday, a cowherd from the region was attacked by hundreds of Palestinians from Umm Tzafa. When the IDF failed to deploy forces to protect him from the hundreds of Palestinians attacking him and his cows with fireworks and rocks, he called the residents in the surrounding villages, who broke the Sabbath restrictions to save him. Rather than thank the Jewish villagers, the IDF joined Peace Now and other leftist and anarchist groups in castigating them as violent thugs for brandishing their weapons to protect the cowherd.

Later that evening, still raging from the attempted murder of their friend just days after four of their friends were murdered at Eli, dozens of area residents entered Umm Tzafa and carried out their arson attacks. While deserving of condemnation and criminal, the arson rampage looks a lot different when seen in the context of events, including the IDF's inaction.

This is the heart of the problem. While the immediate cause of the expansion of the terrorist infrastructure in Jenin was Fuchs's stand-down order in September 2021, the deeper reason Jenin has become a mini-Gaza is rooted in Israel's disastrous 2005 withdrawal from northern Samaria. At the time, believing that the P.A. would behave responsibly and quell the terror groups operating in the region, the Sharon government ordered the destruction of four Israeli communities and the withdrawal of the IDF from its brigade headquarters in the area.

In the event, depending on whom you talk to, the P.A. either lost control over the region and Iranian-backed terror groups took over, or, according to Fatah, the P.A. has led the Iranian-backed terror groups in their transformation of the region into a second Gaza Strip. Recognizing that the 2005 withdrawal, rather than "settler violence," forms the root of the present crisis, in March the coalition repealed the 2005 Disengagement Law in relation to northern Samaria. The move was the first step towards enabling the repopulation of the destroyed communities, beginning with Homesh, where the government approved the operation of a yeshiva.

Presumably, the move also presages the return of the Menashe Territorial Brigade (also known as the Jenin Brigade) to its original position.

Since Israel has not applied its law to Judea and Samaria, for the Knesset's action to go into effect, Gen. Fuchs must sign an administrative order. To date, Fuchs has refused to sign the order. By so acting, Fuchs actively subverts and prevents the government from implementing its strategic vision for northern Samaria.

### **Empty suit**

To be sure, Netanyahu said this week that he opposes any effort to dismantle the P.A. But it is not at all clear that the decision is Israel's to make. As Arab affairs commentator Baruch Yedid reported on Monday morning, a recent poll showed that 50% of Palestinians believe it is their national interest to dismantle the P.A. Sixty-three percent want Abbas to resign. Seventy-one percent support the terror groups operating in northern Samaria.

Beyond that, the term "Palestinian Authority" is an empty suit. The question is who fills it and what he does. The Netanyahu government does not view the P.A. as presently constituted as a positive force or one interested in fighting terrorism. And given its personnel's leading role in terrorism, the government's view is grounded in reality.

From the top officer's statements to *Hakol Hayehudi*, and from statements by Fuchs and IDF Chief of Staff Lt. Gen. Herzl Halevi, it is apparent that the IDF's strategic vision for the region is far different. It is more aligned with the Biden administration's policies than with the Netanyahu government's policies. Like the administration, the IDF's top leadership views the Jewish communities in the region as obstacles to security and the P.A. as the preferred partner for fighting Palestinian terrorism.

What this means is that the limited, tactical operation in Jenin the IDF is currently undertaking is the best that we can expect to receive in Judea and Samaria for now. So long as Fuchs remains the commanding officer, and so long as the IDF General Staff refuses to accept strategic realities unaligned with its leadership's ideological convictions, there is unlikely to be any positive strategic shift in the reality on the ground.

#### **Netanyahu also notes plan to turn Israel into AI superpower. "This is the future and we are going there."**

At the weekly Israeli cabinet meeting on Sunday, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu discussed plans for a transportation "revolution" in Israel.

"Today, we are launching the 'One Israel' project – to link the entire country with a fast railway from Kiryat Shemona to Eilat," Netanyahu announced.

"This project is underway with a NIS 100 billion multi-year budget. My vision is that every citizen in the country will be able to go to and from the center of the country, from anywhere in the state, in less than two hours.

"In most cases, it will be less than one hour – and even less than that. No traffic jams, no air pollution no parking problems – comfortably and safely, a huge revolution," he explained.

"I would like to thank the previous, energetic, Transportation Minister, Yisrael Katz, and the current, energetic, Transportation Minister, Miri Regev, and also the many other ministers who joined the effort in realizing this vision, which will change the face of the country."

Netanyahu added that "In the future, we will be able to transport freight by rail from Eilat to our Mediterranean Sea ports,

and we will also be able to link Israel by rail to Saudi Arabia and the Arabian Peninsula. We are working on this as well."

#### **The prime minister also discussed plans to turn Israel into an AI "superpower."**

"Who seizes the future now? Whoever seizes the future and turns Israel – this is our plan – into one of the five world superpowers in artificial intelligence," he said.

"Just as we did in cyber, so we will turn Israel not into a rising force among the nations, but a superpower among the nations. This is our plan.

"We will not just provide relief for the cost of living, which we have lowered, and the transportation, housing, education and social welfare for the citizens of Israel – we want, and must, turn the State of Israel into a superpower among the nations in artificial intelligence. This is the future and we are going there."

Netanyahu also commented [threats](#) made by Hezbollah leader Hassan Nasrallah over the weekend.

Nasrallah said Hezbollah "will not hesitate and will be ready for any development or stupidity" on Israel's part.

"The Zionist entity is the source of evil and a cancerous growth in our region. Our region will not calm down until this cancerous growth and this germ of corruption is removed. We in Hezbollah stand by the resistance of the Palestinian people," Nasrallah added.

"Regarding Nasrallah's threats from his bunker," Netanyahu said, "we are not impressed. At the crucial moment, he will find us standing together, shoulder to shoulder. Even Nasrallah knows that it is worth neither his while, nor Lebanon's, to put us to the test."

# Not a 'one-off': Israel will continue 'mowing the lawn' in Jenin

July 6, 2023



Comments by Israeli leaders in the aftermath of a two-day incursion in the Jenin refugee camp indicate that the Israel Defense Forces will take repeated military action against Palestinian terror. "At these moments we are completing the mission, and I can say that our extensive operation in Jenin is not a one-off," said Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu on Tuesday evening as Israeli forces were leaving the Palestinian city. "We will eradicate terrorism wherever we see it and we will strike at it."

Defense Minister Yoav Gallant made the same point on Wednesday when he stressed, "If Jenin returns to terror, we will return to Jenin – and it will happen much faster and with much greater power than what people might imagine. Whoever does not understand this today, will understand it very soon."

Many Israelis refer to this type of conflict management as "mowing the lawn," Dr. Emmanuel Navon explained to the Tazpit Press Service. Dr. Navon is a professor of political science at

Tel Aviv University and a Senior Fellow at the Jerusalem Institute for Strategy and Security.



"The concept of mowing the lawn is that often, the IDF has to act either in the West Bank [Judea and Samaria] or in the Gaza Strip to fight terrorist organizations. But it doesn't mean of course that as a result of the operation, the terror goes away. It keeps growing back. It's like grass, and they need to mow it again and again," Navon said.

"Obviously this is not a long term solution," he stressed, adding that in the absence of strong Palestinian leadership, "Israel has no other choice but to act over and over again. Hence the concept of mowing the lawn, because the terror groups rearm and regroup and rebuild and therefore those operations repeat themselves."

The operation, Navon explained, was to "fill the void left by the collapsing Palestinian Authority. The forces of the PA are no longer able or willing to face the terrorist organizations. There's no other

choice for Israel but to act whenever there are clear indications of potential terrorist attacks.”

In 2023, 50 shooting attacks against Israelis came from the Jenin Camp. Since September, 19 terrorists have fled to the camp after carrying out attacks.

Asked about the timing of the raid, Navon said, “I think it was an issue of intelligence showing clear and immediate danger with the terror groups reaching an amount of weaponry amassed by the terror organizations in Jenin that turned into an immediate and clear danger.”

Israeli soldiers in the refugee camp uncovered bomb-making laboratories, [stockpiles of explosives](#), a [tunnel running from a mosque](#), and seized a home-made rocket launcher.

#### **‘Business as usual’**

Navon said there was no way to know how long Israel might enjoy a lull in terror from Jenin before having to take action again because the Palestinian Authority is in “slow collapse” and “nobody knows how long Mahmoud Abbas will be around.”

The Israeli raid, he said, “basically confirms that the PA is no longer in charge, and it will have an impact on how the PA is perceived by the Palestinians as being not only corrupt, but weak.” As for the refugee camp, it will return to “business as usual,” Navon predicted, saying, “The terror groups now know what Israel knows about them, about their structure and their weapons, and therefore they are likely to change and modify their modus operandi.”

Navon was sharply critical of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency, which administers the camp of 18,000 Palestinians.

“UNRWA has always been part of the problem and not part of the solution. [UNRWA brainwashes](#)

[Palestinians](#) to hate Israel and gives them the illusion that they have a simple “right of return” to Israel proper,” Navon said.

Established in 1953, the Jenin refugee camp is often referred to by Palestinians as the “Martyr’s Capital.” Between 2000-2003, during the Second Intifada, at least 28 Palestinian suicide bombers came from the Jenin camp.
